**SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2010**  
**“Desensitize Your Horse” Clinic**  
**At Home, on the Trail, or at the Show**

Participate and bring your horse to experience new obstacles or fear factors for you and your horse to help you get through it all and learn how to practice at home and at the barn. My goal is to teach you how to help yourself and your buddy!

**The goal is to help make something less responsive to an overwhelming fear by repeated exposure to the feared situation or object, either in natural or artificial circumstances.**

We will be using simple things around the house, the barn, out on the trail, and some things you have never thought of to help you understand how to work with your horse to get them over fears that may exist. You just need to know HOW to help your horse get through it all so that you can practice at home.

You need to have a halter and lead rope, and your saddle (if you want to ride through some obstacles). The clinic will have a lot of ground work with horses, and then riders will be instructed on how to help their horse through situations. All children need to wear a helmet.

Come find out what your horse(s) fear factor is, so I can help you, to help your horse get through them. Don't forget, you and your horse should always be a team!

I will help you to understand game playing with your horse to help you understand how to help your horse really trust you emphatically (and you to trust your horse).

If your horse has a particular issue, please call me prior to the clinic. I can help you prepare a head of time and make sure we cover your issue.

I want your horse to allow you, and him/her to have different situations, objects, etc. become part of your lives so it's something you both don't fear.

The association and/or the Utah State Fair reserves the right to amend or add to these rules, as it, in its judgement, may deem advisable.

ALL HORSES EXHIBITED IN THIS SHOW WILL BE DONE SO  
AT THE OWNER'S RISK ENTIRELY.

### **LIABILITY OF EXHIBITORS AND PATRONS**

In no case shall the Utah State Fair and/or the Utah All Breed Horse Association or any of their Officers or Members of the Board be held responsible for damage in any loss, damage, injury, death or disability by disease or from theft or from any other cause to any such property, or to any person coming upon said State Fairpark while said persons or property are on said State Fairpark. The Utah State Fair and/or the Utah All Breed Horse Association hereby refuse to assume any responsibility for the safety as bailee or otherwise, of any property brought upon said State Fairpark, said property being brought upon and kept upon said Fairpark at the Owner's Risk. Each exhibitor shall be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person, whosoever, by an animal exhibited, and each exhibitor shall indemnify the Utah State Fair Utah State Fair and/or the Utah All Breed Horse Association and/or Office thereof, against all claims or demands of any kind or nature that may grow out of any injury occasioned by the animal exhibited or arise from the negligence of the person in charge of such animal. It will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Utah State Fair and/or the Utah All Breed Horse Association blameless of any loss or accident to his or her horse, horses, or equipment that may result from sickness, death, theft, fire or otherwise. All Owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damages incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

### **PARKING AND TRAILERS**

Parking for all horse events is in Lot E, (Gate # 17) which is located at 300 N. 1200 W. Fair tickets can be purchased at this location as well. The Salt Lake City Board of Health Rules and Regulations will not allow the Fair to have trailers or campers on the grounds that are not self-contained (Exceptions: these vehicles may park for short periods of time during judging in the area east of the horse arena.) All horse trailers can unload for 30 MINUTES ONLY in the east, west or north side of the green barn. Once unloaded, all trailers may be parked along the west fence (behind the green barn) or against the far north chain link fence by the outdoor arena. DO NOT back the trailers against the rail of the out door arena. This space is provided for the heavy horses during the horse pull for easy access. If you park against the out door arena during the heavy horse pull and your trailer is damaged by the horses, neither the UABHA nor the FAIRPARK will be responsible for the damage. There is absolutely no parking in between the main arena and the main green barn or between barns 46, 47, 48, and 49! No Exceptions!!! Please park all trucks in front of unhitched trailer in order to provide space for other trailers. PLEASE BE MINDFUL OF OTHERS AND RESPECTFUL TO PARKING ATTENDENTS. Please note the map of the arena area and parking restrictions that has been provided in this premium book.

## **RELEASE OF HORSES FROM GROUNDS**

All exhibitors must have a written release from the Horse Show Management in addition to proper proof of ownership or brand inspections before leaving the show grounds with their horses. The Manager or Show Secretary will sign Release Forms which must be presented at the gate before animals will be released. All trailers will be checked at the Gate for proper paperwork.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

- No dogs will be allowed on the grounds.
- Barn wiring is not set up to carry excessive loads of electricity. Check with the Supervisor before using connections for special hook-ups.
- Showers are available at the Midway Restroom Area and Multi-Purpose building.
- All prizes will be awarded at the earliest possible time after Judging. Premium money will be paid by check within 30 days of the closing of the Horse Show, and checks will be made out in the Owner's name only. Premium checks not cashed within 60 days of issue will become null and void.
- Animals must be in show condition, clean and trim, or Judge may refuse to place. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judge or Officials of the Show on the part of an exhibitor, owner, groom, rider or driver of any horse on exhibition will disqualify such horse/s from competition and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees and any previous winnings of that entry.

You may reserve a tack stall only if you have reserved 8 or more stalls for horses. **You must check with Alese before putting any horse in any stall.** If she is unavailable during show hours, stall keys are also available in the show office and the maintenance barn. **Please inform her if you will be arriving after hours (7:00 A.M. - 10:00 P.M.)**

It is the Exhibitors responsibility to arrange for their own feed, bedding, etc. Exhibitors must keep stalls, runways, and pens clean and litter must be deposited in places so designated by the Supervisor. Exhibitors failing to comply with this Board of Health Rule will not be permitted to show and entry fees and money won will be forfeited and exhibitor may be asked to remove his horse from the Fairpark. Animals should be clean and properly fed and cared for at all times throughout the show.

#### **HEALTH REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS**

All horses entering the fair must be in a good health. Utah Brand Inspection or proof of ownership is required. All out-of-state horses must have a current valid health certificate including a Negative Coggins Test within one year. Department Supervisors or State Veterinarian may check all required health and travel papers. Release forms from the show secretary are required for all horses leaving the Fairpark.

#### **REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS**

- PLEASE FILL OUT ENTRY FORM CORRECTLY AND COMPLETELY.
- All breeds must be entered and shown in accordance with their respective breed rules.
- Horses showing in a specific breed division must be registered in that breed and must be shown under their full registered names with registration numbers provided .
- Non-registered horses or cross bred horses may not show in pure bred classes but are welcome in all Open Division Classes (Open English Pleasure, Open Hunter Pleasure, Open Western Pleasure, etc.)

#### **PROCEDURES AND CONDUCT OF EXHIBITORS**

A Judge may not be approached during the show by an exhibitor of a horse shown, his agent, employee rider, stable manager, groom or member of such persons' family with regard to any decision made at the show. Any exhibitor wishing to talk with a Judge following the show may do so by contacting the Manager who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place. A JUDGE'S DECISION IN ALL CLASSES SHALL BE CONSIDERED FINAL.

#### **PROTESTS**

A protest must be filed as set forth in **USEF RULE VI, Chapter I**. Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in the governing rules of the USEF, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee, whose decision shall be final. Five members of the Governing Body will hear protests.

#### **MINIMUM ENTRIES**

Three entries shall constitute a class. In the event there are fewer than three entries, a class may be canceled or combined at the discretion of the Show Management.

#### **TBA CLASSES**

TBA classes are classes in which we have had little or no participation with in the past. Time is allotted at the end of most sessions for a TBA class to run, if desired. There is a \$25.00 fee to add a TBA class if there are less than three in the class. High point TBA classes have no charge. Regular entry fees apply to enter class. Open TBA classes offer ribbons. Championship TBA classes offer ribbons and awards (if available), but no prize money. If you are interested in adding a TBA class, you must let the show management know before the session is to begin. If secretary is notified of a TBA class before entry deadline of September 3, class will be printed on the class sheets handed out at the show. #### **CHAMPIONSHIP OR STAKE ELIGIBILITY**

All horses entered, shown and judged in a qualifying performance class are eligible to enter their respective Championship class regardless of qualifying class placements. **THE TOP THREE RIBBON WINNERS IN QUALIFYING CLASSES MUST SHOW BACK IN THEIR CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES OR FORFEIT ANY PREMIUM MONEY WON.** All Championship Entries must be made in the Show Office no later than ONE HOUR prior to the beginning of the session in which that class is scheduled to be run.

#### **THREE-MINUTE GATE RULE**

Three minutes will be allowed after the first horse enters the ring, until the gate will be closed. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to be aware of what class is in the ring and be on time to check in with the Paddock Master. Requests for "Gate Holds" must be made with the Paddock Master and the Secretary prior to the beginning of the session, but there can be no guarantees that a class will be held for an exhibitor even though the request has been made.

**We will be starting each session on time.** Entrants should plan on being in warm up arena, and ready to go five minutes prior to their class. There will only be two changes allowed per session. Requests for changes must be approved by show management and will be allowed for emergency purposes only. Changes will be granted at a first-come-first-served basis. Your cooperation is appreciated.

**RETURNED CHECKS:** There will be a penalty fee of \$30.00 charged for entries paid for by a check that is returned by the bank for any reason. To retain entries, both entry fees and penalty fees must be paid by MONEY ORDER, CASHIERS CHECK, OR CASH before receiving entry packet. In the event that a check is returned after the show is complete, the Owner's name will be listed publicly and they shall be turned away from all other Approved Shows until the matter is cleared up satisfactorily.

#### **PREMIUMS**

Premium money will be awarded in Championship classes only. Premium money won will be paid by check made out in the name of the recorded owner of the horse or horses. Checks will be mailed within 30 days of the closing of the show, and they must be cashed within 60 days or they will become null and void. Ribbons - first through fifth place will be awarded in all classes. Trophies to all exhibitors in Open Lead Line.

#### **DEFINITION OF CLASSES**

**LIMIT:** A "Limit" class is open to horses who have not won six first place ribbons at a Regular Show in the particular division in which they are entered. A "Limit" entry is such from the closing date of entries.

**NOVICE:** A "Novice" class is open to horses who have not won three first place ribbons at a Regular Show in the particular division in which they are entered. A "Novice" entry is such from the closing date of entries.

**MAIDEN:** A "Maiden" class is open to horses who have not won any first place ribbons at a Regular Show in the particular division in which they are entered. A "Maiden" entry is such from the closing date of entries.

**OPEN:** An "Open" class is open to horses of any breed or mixed breed, registered or non -registered and shown in accordance with class specifications.

**JUNIOR HORSE:** A "Junior Horse" class is open to horses four years of age and under for all breeds except Arabians which is open to horses five years and under. For horse show purposes, any horse shall be considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling.

**JUNIOR EXHIBITORS:** A "Junior Exhibitor" class is open to exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1. For horse show purposes, the age of an individual on December 1 shall be maintained through the show year. Persons born on December 1 shall assume the greater age on that date.

**AMATEUR:** An "Amateur" class is open to individuals who qualify under the USA Equestrian definition and have reached their 18th birthday. All individuals 18 years of age or over must meet the qualifications. If you do not qualify as an Amateur your entries will be refused for all classes designated as Amateur to Ride or Drive. This will be strictly enforced. Junior Exhibitors are automatically considered Amateur and are eligible to participate in certain breed classes for Amateurs (i.e. Morgans, Arabians).

**SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR HALTER CLASSES JUDGING**

All animals must be paraded in the ring when so ordered by the Show Management and anyone failing to comply with this rule will be liable to forfeit any prize to which he may be entitled. In case of one entry in a class, an inferior animal will not be awarded a prize.

Judge must not award prizes to an unworthy exhibitor. It is the intention of the Management that no premium or distinction of any kind shall be given to an animal or article that is not deserving. This rule must be strictly adhered to whether or not there is competition.

Objection to any person or Judge must be made to the Director in writing prior to an award made, giving good and sufficient reason therefore. A protest against a Judge on the grounds of incompetence or previous bias must be made to the Supervisor or Manager. A protest against an award must be made in writing, before the close of the day following the making of such an award, stating the exact reason for the same and must be accompanied by an affidavit and deposit of \$25. In the case the protest is not sustained the deposit shall be forfeited to the Fair. The Manager will notify the exhibitor of the protested animal of such protests and both parties shall then have ten days to produce sworn testimony in the case. No payment will be made on the protested awards until final action is taken thereon by the Board. If it be ascertained that any exhibitor has, in an ungentlemanly and public manner, taken exception to the Judgment or ruling of a Judge, employee or any official of the UTAH STATE FAIR, the board can bar said person so offending from competing for a premium or exhibiting on the grounds until he shall have made proper apology and been reinstated by the Board.
