"EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF CURRENT US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH."

LIABILITY OF EXHIBITORS AND PATRONS

ALL HORSES EXHIBITED IN THIS SHOW WILL BE DONE SO AT THE OWNER'S RISK ENTIRELY.

In no case shall the American Saddle Horse Association of Utah or any of their Officers or Members of the Board be held responsible for damage in any loss, damage, injury, death or disability by disease or from theft or from any other cause to any such property, or to any person coming upon said South Jordan Equestrian Park while said persons or property are on said South Jordan Equestrian Park. The American Saddle Horse Association of Utah hereby refuses to assume any responsibility for the safety as bailee or otherwise, of any property brought upon said South Jordan Equestrian Park, said property being brought upon and kept upon said South Jordan Equestrian Park at the Owner's Risk.

Each exhibitor shall be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person, whosoever, by an animal exhibited, and each exhibitor shall indemnify the American Saddle Horse Association of Utah and/or Office thereof, against all claims or demands of any kind or nature that may grow out of any injury occasioned by the animal exhibited or arise from the negligence of the person in charge of such animal.

It will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the American Saddle Horse Association of Utah blameless of any loss or accident to his or her horse, horses, or equipment that my result from sickness, death, theft, fire or otherwise.

All Owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damages incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly. The Management reserves the right to exclude from the grounds any person or persons whom they deem undesirable, or expel from the grounds such person or persons who shall violate any of the published rules.

ENTRIES CLOSE June 3, 2010. Entries post-marked after midnight, June 3, 2010 shall be considered Post-Entries and will be accepted at a Penalty Fee of \$10.00 per horse in addition to normal entry fees.

*****All entry fees must be paid in full when submitting entry forms. Open checks will be accepted; however there will be no deducting of premiums. All premiums will be paid in full as well. There will be no exceptions to this rule.**

In all cases, the management reserves the right to reject or accept an entry to this show without being liable for compensation. To be accepted, ALL ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED BY THE EXHIBITOR AND TRAINER. If the exhibitor is 18 years of age or younger, the entry form must be signed by a parent or guardian. Please fill out the entry form completely. All information must be included and ALL ENTRY FEES AND STALL FEES PAID IN FULL to be accepted. In any event, exhibitors canceling their entries for any reason after the official closing date (other than by written Veterinarian excuse) shall forfeit all entry and stall fees. Horses excused by a veterinarian shall have all entry fees refunded with the exception of office fees.

ALL HORSES ENTERING THE SHOW MUST BE IN GOOD HEALTH

Animals must be in show condition, clean and trimmed, or Judge may refuse to place. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judge or Officials of the Show on the part of an exhibitor, owner, groom, rider or driver of any horse on exhibition will disqualify such horse/s from competition and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees and any previous winnings of that entry.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES - BRAND INSPECTIONS

Health certificates and brand inspections must be available for examination. Note: Brand inspectors are doing random inspections.

REGISTRATION OF HORSES

All horses must be registered with their respective breed organizations and must be entered and shown under their full registered names.

HIGH POINT CLASSES

Anyone wishing to go for a year-end High Point Award must be a member of the UABHA. Points will start accumulating after the membership registration has been received. **Owners, and riders must both be members in order for points to count.** You can get membership applications at the show office. High Point classes are identified by *** in the Breed Division section of this premium book.

MINIMUM ENTRIES

Three (3) entries shall constitute a class. In the event of fewer than three entries, a class may be canceled or combined at the management's discretion.

TBA CLASSES

TBA classes are classes in which we have had little or no participation with in the past. Time is allotted at the end of most sessions for a TBA class. It is required that TBA classes be sponsored. Performance class: \$30.00, Championship class: \$50.00, Youth class: \$20.00, Youth Championship class: \$30.00, Halter class: \$25.00. Regular entry fees apply. Open TBA classes offer ribbons. Championship TBA classes offer ribbons and premium purse and awards (if available). See possible TBA classes in different breed divisions, or add and sponsor your favorite class! If you are interested in adding a TBA class, you must let the show management know before the session is to begin. If secretary is notified of a TBA class before entry deadline of June 3, class will be printed on the class sheets handed out at the show. CHAMPIONSHIP OR STAKE ELIGIBILITY

All horses entered, shown and judged in a qualifying performance class are eligible to enter their respective Championship class regardless of qualifying class placements. Only the classes immediately above the championship class will qualify for that championship class. If you do enter a championship class and have not qualified, you will forfeit your ribbon, and your entry fees. **THE TOP THREE RIBBON WINNERS IN QUALIFYING CLASSES MUST SHOW BACK IN THEIR CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES (EXCEPT IN CASES WHERE AN EXHIBITOR HAS QUALIFIED MORE THAN ONE HORSE FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP, IN WHICH CASE HE MAY ELECT WHICH HORSE TO SHOW BACK).** All Championship Entries must be made in the Show Office no later than **ONE HOUR** prior to the beginning of the session in which that class is scheduled to be held.

PREMIUMS

Premium money won will be paid by check made out in the name of the recorded owner of the horse or horses. Checks will be mailed within 30 days of the closing of the show, and they must be cashed within 60 days or they will become null and void. Trophies and premium monies will be awarded in Championship classes only. Ribbons - first through fifth place in all classes. Trophies to all exhibitors in Open Lead Line.

SCHOOLING CLASSES

Schooling will not be allowed in regular open classes. If you would like to add a class to school your horse, you may do so as a TBA class.

PROTESTS

A protest must be filed as set forth in **USEF RULE VI, Chapter I**. Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in the governing rules of the USEF, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee, whose decision shall be final. Five members of the Governing Body will hear protests.

STALL ARRANGEMENTS

Stalls cost **\$65.00** for the show or **\$30.00/day**. There will be a grounds fee charge of \$15.00 per horse for exhibitors not renting stalls. **EACH HORSE MUST PAY EITHER \$15.00 GROUNDS FEE OR APPROPRIATE STALL FEE.**

Alese Cunningham, 801-755-4789 will be the stall manager. She shall have entire charge of assigning of stalls for animals exhibited. **ALL** stalls will be assigned on a first-come-first-served basis. You must check with Alese before putting any horse in any stall. **You must talk directly to Alese in order to get your stalls opened. Please inform her if you will be arriving after hours (7:00 A.M. - 10:00 P.M.)**

****To reserve stalls, money must be sent in advance. No stalls shall be assigned without appropriate fees paid. If you set up stalls before Wednesday, June 10, 2010; arrangements must be made with the management of the Equestrian Center for payment of the first night.**

TWO-MINUTE GATE RULE

Two minutes will be allowed after the first horse enters the ring, until the gate will be closed. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to be aware of what class is in the ring and be on time to check in with the Paddock Master. Requests for "Gate Holds" must be made with the Paddock Master prior to the beginning of the session, but there can be no guarantees that a class will be held for an exhibitor even though the request has been made.

We will be starting each session on time. Entrants should plan on being in warm up arena, and ready to go five minutes prior to their class. There will only be two changes allowed per session. Requests for changes must be approved by show management and will be allowed for emergency purposes only. Changes will be granted at a first-come-first-served basis. Your cooperation is appreciated.

SPONSORSHIPS

Sponsorships are necessary to pay for the show. Your support is greatly appreciated. Sponsorships will be announced during each session of the show.

RETURNED CHECKS

There will be a penalty fee of \$25.00 charged for entries paid for by a check that is returned by the bank for any reason. To retain entries, both entry fees and penalty fees must be paid by MONEY ORDER, CASHIERS CHECK, OR CASH before receiving entry packet. If you have had a check "bounce" any previous year, you will be on a **CASH ONLY - UP FRONT** basis.

STATUS & DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Limit, Novice or Maiden status will change as ribbons are won at any USEF rated or UABHA Approved High Point Show, or any Breed Show that is a point show for that breed, in the particular division in which they are entered. Status is such from closing date of entries.

"MAIDEN": A "Maiden" class is open to horses that have not won **any first place** ribbons at a Point Show in the particular division in which they are entered. A "Maiden" entry is such from the closing date of entries.

"NOVICE": A "Novice" class is open to horses who have not won **three first place** ribbons at a Point Show in the particular division in which they are entered. A "Novice" entry is such from the closing date of entries.

"LIMIT": A "Limit" class is open to horse who have not won **six first place** ribbons at a Point Show in the particular division in which they are entered.

"OPEN": An "Open" class is open to horses of any age or sex shown by an exhibitor of any age, sex, unless otherwise specified in the class specifications.

"JUNIOR HORSE": A "Junior Horse" class is open to horses four years of age and under for all breeds except Arabians which is open to horses five years and under. For horse show purposes, any horse shall be considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling.

"JUNIOR EXHIBITORS": A "Junior Exhibitor" class is open to exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1. For horse show purposes, the age of an individual on December 1 shall be maintained through the show year. Persons born on December 1 shall assume the greater age on that date.

Stallions will be permitted in Arabian Junior Exhibitor classes with the condition that the owners and parents are totally responsible and any unruly stallion will be dismissed from the class.

"AMATEUR": An "Amateur" class is open to individuals who qualify under the USE definition and have reached their 18th birthday. All individuals 18 years of age or over must meet the qualifications. If you do not qualify as an Amateur your entries will be refused for all classes designated as Amateur to Ride or Drive. This will be strictly enforced. Junior Exhibitors are automatically considered Amateur and are eligible to participate in certain breed classes for Amateurs (i.e. Morgans).

SALT LAKE COUNTY EQUESTRIAN PARK RULES

- No parking between 700 & 800 barns except to load and unload. Parking is east of 800 barn. This area needs to stay clear for horses entering the ring.
- RV's may park on grounds
- Under no circumstances may RV's hook into the barn's electricity. It will blow out all power
- RV Dump – \$2.00
- No horses will be allowed to be tied to trailers overnight.

MISCELLANEOUS

No dogs will be allowed on the grounds without a leash. Guard dogs must be kept in stalls away from public.
