EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT 10 & UNDER CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS.

**"EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND
SPECIFICATIONS OF CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED
AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH."**

LIABILITY OF EXHIBITORS AND PATRONS

**ALL HORSES EXHIBITED IN THIS SHOW WILL BE DONE SO AT THE OWNER'S RISK
ENTIRELY.** In no case shall the Utah All Breed Horse Association or any of their Officers or
Members of the Board be held responsible for damage in any loss, damage, injury, death or
disability by disease or from theft or from any other cause to any such property, or to any
person coming upon said USU Bastian Agricultural Center while said persons or property are
on said USU Bastian Agricultural Center. The Utah All Breed Horse Association hereby
refuses to assume any responsibility for the safety as bailee or otherwise, of any property
brought upon said USU Bastian Agricultural Center, said property being brought upon and
kept upon said USU Bastian Agricultural Center at the Owner's Risk.

Each exhibitor shall be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person,
whosoever, by an animal exhibited, and each exhibitor shall indemnify the Utah All Breed
Horse Association and/or Office thereof, against all claims or demands of any kind or nature
that may grow out of any injury occasioned by the animal exhibited or arise from the
negligence of the person in charge of such animal.

**It will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Utah All Breed Horse
Association blameless of any loss or accident to his or her horse, horses, or equipment
that my result from sickness, death, theft, fire or otherwise.**

All Owners and Exhibitors will be held responsible for any damages incurred by them or their
agents to barns or other properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly. The
Management reserves the right to exclude from the grounds any person or persons whom
they deem undesirable or expel from the grounds such person or persons who shall violate
any of the published rules.

**PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE YOUR HORSE UNATTENDED UNLESS YOU HORSE IS
SECURE IN A STALL OR A HORSE TRAILER! THIS IS A HUGE LIABILITY!**

ALL HORSES ENTERING THE SHOW MUST BE IN GOOD HEALTH

Animals must be in show condition, clean and trimmed, or Judge may refuse to place. Any
act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judge or Officials of the Show on the part of an
exhibitor, owner, groom, rider or driver of any horse on exhibition will disqualify such horse/s
from competition and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees and any previous
winnings of that entry.

In all cases, the management reserves the right to reject or accept an entry to this show
without being liable for compensation. To be accepted, **ALL ENTRY FORMS MUST BE
SIGNED BY THE EXHIBITOR AND TRAINER. IF THE EXHIBITOR IS 18 YEARS OF AGE
OR YOUNGER, THE ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN.**

Please fill out the entry form completely. All information must be included and **ALL ENTRY FEES AND STALL FEES PAID IN FULL** to be accepted. **There will be a \$50.00 fee added to any entry that is not paid in full by the end of the show.** In any event, exhibitors canceling their entries for any reason after the official closing date (other than by written Veterinarian excuse) shall forfeit all entry and stall fees. Horses excused by a veterinarian shall have entry fees refunded only but **NOT OFFICE FEES.**

USU BASTIAN AGRICULTURAL CENTER RULES

- No parking between the 700 & 800 barns except to load and unload. Parking is east of the 800 barn. This area needs to stay clear for horses entering the ring.
- RV's may park on grounds. For electrical hook ups, it will cost \$30/day.
- Under no circumstances may RV's hook into the barn's electricity. It will blow out all power.
- Horses will not be allowed to be tied to trailers overnight.
- Dogs are no longer allowed inside the arena. All dogs in the barn area must be contained on a leash or locked in a stall. Please do not let dogs run unattended. **Guard dogs must be kept in stalls away from public.**

ENTRIES CLOSE Entries post-marked after the due date, shall be considered Post-Entries and will be accepted at a Penalty Fee of \$20.00 per horse in addition to normal entry fees.

****All entry fees must be paid in full when submitting entry forms. Open checks will be accepted. All premiums will be paid in full as well. There will be no exceptions to this rule.**

****Any entry made during the session in which the class is set to run will be charged a penalty fee of \$5.00 per class. This includes all championships. You may want to nominate for a championship to avoid this charge.**

STALL ARRANGEMENTS

Stalls cost \$85.00/entire show, \$50/day (**NO LONGER INCLUDES SHAVINGS**). There will be a grounds fee charge for exhibitors not renting stalls of **\$25.00/horse/day. EACH HORSE MUST PAY EITHER A STALL FEE OR GROUNDS FEE.** Lee Whitehead, 801-413-8735 will be the stall manager. She shall have entire charge of assigning of stalls for animals exhibited. All stalls will be assigned on a first-come-first-served (paid) basis. You must check with a stall manager before putting any horse in any stall. **Please inform her if you will be arriving after hours between 9:00 PM – 7:00 AM.**

You are responsible for any damage done to your stalls!

****If you need to set up stalls before 10:00 AM on Wednesday, or need to stay in them until Sunday, arrangements must be made with the stall manager or show secretary at least one week in advance! There will be an extra fee for doing so.**

MINIMUM ENTRIES

Three (3) entries shall constitute a class. In the event of fewer than three entries, a class may be canceled or combined at the management's discretion.

HIGH POINT CLASSES

Anyone wishing to go for a year-end High Point Award must be a member of the UABHA. Points will start accumulating after the membership registration has been received. **Owners and riders must both be members in order for points to count.** You can get membership applications on the website uabha.com and at the show office. High Point classes are identified by *** in the Breed Division section of this premium book.

TBA CLASSES

Time is allotted at the end of most sessions for a TBA class to run, if desired. **There is a \$15.00 fee to add a TBA class if there are less than three in the class.** Any Arabian class that is recognized by AHA can be added as a TBA with the exception of Dressage, Sport Horse, cattle work, etc. Regular entry fees apply to enter class. High point TBA classes have no charge. If you are interested in adding a TBA class, you must let the show management know before the session is to begin. SCHOOLING CLASSES

Schooling will not be allowed in regular open classes.

CHAMPIONSHIP OR STAKE ELIGIBILITY

All horses entered, shown and judged in a qualifying performance class are eligible to enter their respective Championship class regardless of qualifying class placements. Only the classes immediately above the championship class will qualify for that championship class. If you do enter a championship class and don't qualify, you will forfeit your ribbon, and your entry fees. All Championship Entries should be made in the Show Office no later than ONE HOUR prior to the beginning of the session in which that class to be held.

TWO-MINUTE GATE RULE

Two minutes will be allowed after the first horse enters the ring, until the gate will be closed. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to be aware of what class is in the ring and be on time to check in with the Paddock Master. Requests for "Gate Holds" are allowed **only if you were in the previous class or if there were unexpected cancelled classes.** Requests must be made with the Paddock Master and the Secretary prior to the beginning of the session, but there can be no guarantees that a class will be held for an exhibitor even though the request has been made. **We will be starting each session on time.** Entrants should plan on being in warm up arena, and ready to go five minutes prior to their class. There will only be two changes allowed per session. Requests for changes must be approved by show management and will be allowed for emergency purposes only. Changes will be granted at a first-come-first-served basis. Your cooperation is appreciated.

RETURNED CHECKS

There will be a penalty fee of \$50.00 charged for entries paid for by a check that is returned by the bank for any reason. To retain entries, both entry fees and penalty fees must be paid by MONEY ORDER, CASHIERS CHECK, OR CASH before receiving entry packet. If you have had a check "bounce" any previous year, you will be on a **CASH ONLY - UP FRONT** basis.

PREMIUMS

Premium money won will be paid by check made out in the name of the **recorded owner** of the horse or horses. Checks will be mailed within 30 days of the closing of the show, and they must be **cashed within 60 days** or they will become null and void. Premium monies will be awarded in Adult Performance Championship classes only. There will be no trophies awarded in Championship classes. Ribbons - first through fourth place in all classes. Trophies or medals will be awarded to all exhibitors in Open Lead Line.

STATUS & DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Limit, Novice or Maiden status will change as ribbons are won at any USEF rated or UABHA Approved High Point Show, or any Breed Show that is a point show for that breed, in the particular division in which they are entered. Status is such from closing date of entries.

“MAIDEN”: A “Maiden” class is open to horses that have not won **any first place** ribbons at a Point Show in the particular division in which they are entered. A “Maiden” entry is such from the closing date of entries.

“NOVICE”: A “Novice” class is open to horses/riders who have not won **three first place** ribbons at a Regular Point Show in the particular division in which they are entered. A “Novice” entry is such from the closing date of entries.

“LIMIT”: A “Limit” class is open to horse who have not won **six first place** ribbons at a Point Show in the particular division in which they are entered.

“OPEN”: An “Open” class is open to horses of any age or sex shown by an exhibitor of any age, sex, unless otherwise specified in the class specifications.

“JUNIOR HORSE”: A “Junior Horse” class is open to horses four years of age and under for all breeds except Arabians, TWH and SSH which are open to horses five years and under. For horse show purposes, any horse shall be considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling.

“JUNIOR EXHIBITORS”: A “Junior Exhibitor” class is open to exhibitors who have not reached their 19th birthday as of December 1 of the previous year. For horse show purposes, the age of an individual on December 1 shall be maintained through the show year. Persons born on December 1 shall assume the greater age on that date. Junior exhibitors must be prepared to prove their age. **Stallions will be permitted in Arabian and Half-Arabian Junior Exhibitor classes with the condition that the owners and parents are totally responsible and any unruly stallion will be dismissed from the class. Junior riders must be prepared to prove their age.**

“AMATEUR”: An “Amateur” class is open to individuals who qualify under the USEF definition and haven't reached their 18th birthday. All individuals 18 years of age or over must meet the qualifications. If you do not qualify as an Amateur your entries will be refused for all classes designated as Amateur to Ride or Drive. This will be strictly enforced. Junior Exhibitors are automatically considered Amateur and are eligible to participate in certain breed classes for Amateurs (i.e. Morgans).

***IF YOU ENTER IN ANY WALK TROT CLASS, YOU MAY NOT ENTER IN ANY CANTER CLASS!**

PROTESTS

A protest must be filed as set forth in **USEF RULE VI, Chapter I**. Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in the governing rules of the USEF, the same shall be referred to the Show Committee, whose decision shall be final. Five members of the Governing Body will hear protests.

TWH & SSH EXHIBITORS:

Exhibitors will NOT be required to go through DQP station. All exhibitors will be required to follow all HPA and USDA rules and regulations. Any exhibitor currently under the USDA suspension list will not be allowed on show grounds and will be asked to leave immediately by show management.

UABHA Show Management Amendments to the Walking Horse Owners Association (WHOA) rule book:

- All horses showing in any Tennessee Walking Horse Classes must be registered with Tennessee Walking Horse Breeders and Exhibitors Association "TWHBEA" and able to provide so with a copy of papers to show Management.
- Barefoot horses are eligible to ride in TWH Trail Pleasure, Lite-Shod and Plantation divisions.
- Horses entered in TWH Trail Pleasure classes are eligible to ride in TWH Lite-Shod classes.
- Horses are eligible to jump up only **one** division. Horses entered in TWH Trail Pleasure classes are eligible to ride in TWH Lite-Shod classes. Horses entered in TWH Lite-Shod classes are eligible to ride in TWH Plantation classes, all horses must be TWHBEA registered.
- Management does allow hoof black and hoof bands, but no longer than a 5" toe.
- Dressage saddles are acceptable in English classes. Browbands with rhinestones are acceptable.
- Plantation classes will follow Classic Park rules

TWH SHOE REGULATION

Lite-Shod -The shoes must be made of iron and be no thicker than ½ inch nor any wider than 1 (one) inch with the exception of the caulk, which must be no thicker than 1 inch. The use of borium is permitted on the caulks of light shod shoes, but the thickness of the shoe and caulk with the borium must not exceed 1-1/8 inches. The turnback caulk shall not exceed 1-½ inches (from front to back of the caulk) and the shoe must not extend more than 1/4 inch beyond the hoof at the toe. The shoe is not to extend beyond the bulb of the horse's heel when a perpendicular line is drawn from the bulb of the horse's heel to the ground. The weight-bearing surface of the shoe must be level. Pads of any kind are prohibited. Bands are optional.

Trail Pleasure - The shoes must be made of iron and be no thicker than 3/8 inch and no wider than ¾ wide. The thickness of caulk and borium must not exceed 7/8 inch, and turnback caulk is limited to 1 ½ inches (from front to back of the caulk). Bands are prohibited.

CLASS SELECTION BY BREED AND DIVISIONS

It shall be the responsibility, and a condition of entry to this show, of all Exhibitors to know the rules for their Breed as outlined in the USEF Equestrian Current Rule Book.

ARABIAN DIVISION

All Arabian and Half Arabian classes offered at this show will qualify for AHA Regional and Championship Shows!

ARABIAN PERFORMANCE CLASSES: To be eligible for Championships, horses must have been entered, shown, and judged in their respective qualifying classes. See USEF Current Rule Book for details pertaining to this division. **ARABIAN ENGLISH PLEASURE AND COUNTRY PLEASURE HORSES MAY NOT CROSS ENTER.**

A/HA/AA Country English Pleasure Section

Informal saddle seat tack and attire, no forward seat saddles allowed. To be shown at a Walk, Normal Trot, Strong Trot, Canter, and Hand Gallop. **Amateur classes DO NOT Strong Trot or Hand gallop! It is mandatory, horses must be asked to halt on the rail, stand quietly, back and walk off on a loose rein at least one direction of the ring.**

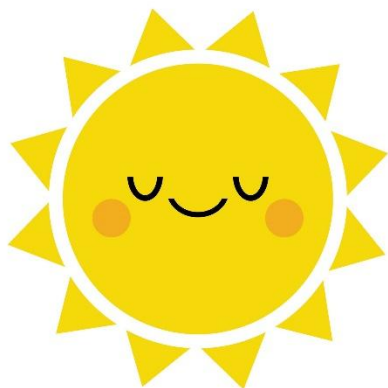
